

Information about the possibility of obtaining a permanent right to stay in Germany through the "Chancen-Aufenthaltsgesetz"

On 02 December 2022, the Bundestag passed the Chancen-Aufenthaltsgesetz (Opportunity Residence Act). This law enables persons who have lived in Germany for at least 5 years as of 31 October 2022 with a Duldung, a Gestattung or a Aufenthaltserlaubnis to obtain an 18-month residence permit. During these 18 months, they have the opportunity to fulfil the requirements for a permanent right to stay in Germany. These are, in particular, securing a livelihood, knowledge of the German language and proof of identity.

Persons who have committed criminal offenses or who prevent their deportation due to repeated, intentional and own false statements or active deception of identity are generally excluded from the Opportunity Residency.
